



# INSTALLING ETCH GRADIENTS


- 1. follow your design
- 2. the design overrules the arrow on the back
- 3. apply 180° U-turn if necessary



Not OK. The arrow on the back was followed.




OK. Floor design was followed.



# ETCH GRADIENTS - EXAMPLE TRANSITION 3 DESIGNS

BRICK INSTALLATION SHOWING TRANSITION FROM ETCH (E) TO ETCH GRADIENT (EG) TO CORE (C)

Here a perfect example of a Etch to Core transition. 4 Etch tiles in the middle & 8 Etch Gradient tiles to transition & 8 Core tiles on the edges.



If your installation is finished, the arrows on the back of the gradients might not all point into the same direction. Some might be turned by 180°. Perfectly fine!

To install this design you might need to turn the gradient tiles by 180° to transition from one pattern to another.
